

## 2018 DATA PROTECTION ACT Privacy Notice for parents / carers

Ousedale School will be processing personal data about its students' parents/carers and is a "data controller" in respect of this for the purposes of the imminent General Data Protection Regulations that will come into force in May 2018. It processes this data to:

- support its students' teaching and learning
- monitor and report on their progress
- provide appropriate pastoral care

This data includes names, addresses, contact numbers, email addresses, relationship to students, and family circumstances. This data will be held securely by the school until the September following a students' 25<sup>th</sup> birthday. This data may only be used or passed on for specific purposes allowed by law. The use of your information for these purposes is lawful for the following reasons:

- The School is under a legal obligation to collect the information or the information is necessary for us to meet legal requirements imposed upon us such as our duty to safeguard students.
- It is necessary for us to hold and use your information for the purposes of our functions in providing schooling and so we can look after our students. This is a function which is in the public interest because everybody needs to have an education. This means we have a real and proper reason to use your information.

When we collect personal information on our forms, we will make it clear whether there is a legal requirement for you to provide it, whether there is a legal requirement on the school to collect it. If there is no legal requirement then we will explain why we need it and what the consequences are if it is not provided.

Parents/carers have certain rights under the Data Protection Act, including a general right to be given access to personal data held about them by any data controller. You have these rights:

- You can ask us for a copy of the information we have about you
- You can ask us to correct any information we have about you if you think it is wrong
- You can ask us to erase information about you (although we may have good reasons why we cannot do this)
- You can ask us to limit what we are doing with your information
- You can object to what we are doing with your information
- You can ask us to transfer your information to another organisation in a format that makes it easy for them to use.

If you wish to see a copy of the information we hold and share about you then please contact Mr Whiting, Data Protection Officer.

For students of 13 years and over, the school is legally required to pass on certain information to the provider of youth support services in the area. This is the local authority support service for all young people aged 13 to 19 in England. This information includes the name, address and date of birth of the student **and** the name and address of the parent/carer, and any further information relevant to the support services' role.

If you require more information about how the Local Authority (LA) and/or DfE store and use your information, please refer to the contact details on the reverse of this letter. Similarly, should you wish to find out more about the General Data Protection Regulations or raise any concerns, please contact the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO).

Similarly, if you wish to raise a query or complaint about the security or use of your data please contact Mr Whiting in the first instance.
