



GUIDELINES FOR BUCKS SCHOOLS AA COMPETITION ENTRY 2025

CLARIFICATIONS

- 1) Each school allowed a maximum of **3 athletes** per event in the Junior (Year 8 & 9) and Intermediate (Yr 10 & 11 age Groups).
- 2) **Years 8, 9, 10 & 11** Each athlete only allowed to enter a **maximum of 3 events** - can be any mix of track and field within UKA rules so Juniors cannot double up 800m / 1500m.
Year 7s: restricted to 2 events only.
- 3) **YEAR 7 Events**
Restricted to events available to Years 7s in ESAA Cup but applying Year 7 specifications (except no 1500m this year)
In all Year 7 track events, events will be held as Time Trials
Year 7 Field events limited to 4 jumps / throws (except High Jump). This may be changed at the discretion of the Field Referee if there are a high number of entries.
- 4) **YEAR 8, 9, 10 and 11 Events**
All events competed at the English Schools National Champs are offered.

Field Events will be held to modified Championships rules - each athletes get 3 attempts - best 6 athletes above a given standard (tbd) get additional 3 attempts.
- 5) **YEAR 12, 13 Events**
This competition is not intended for older students. However, where an athlete is seeking a competition opportunity for strong academic or ESAA qualification reasons the following guidelines apply:

Only events on offer at the Intermediate age group which have the same specifications; hence all throws (except Female Discus) and hurdles excluded.
Athletes may only be allowed to enter the listed events if there are sufficient lanes available in the sprints, and not too many jumpers already. Athletes will not be able to progress through rounds of the competition = for clarification, where there heats, Seniors may only compete in the Heat for the purpose of getting a valid time – they will be excluded from the any Final qualifiers.
- 6) **VERY IMPORTANT**
Junior and Inter athletes seeking selection for the County for the English Schools Championship are expected to compete in the Bucks Schools Championships, but do not necessarily have to compete in the event in which they wish to be selected.
They must have a valid competition performance within the National Entry standards recorded in a Power of 10 eligible competition since January 1st 2025 to be considered for the National Champs. These athletes should be nominated on the Online Form to be considered for selection by the Selectors.
