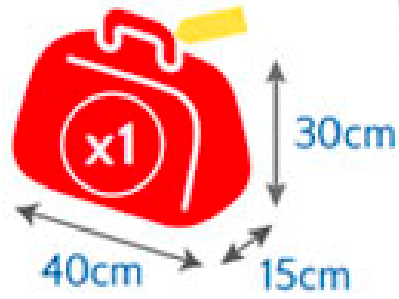




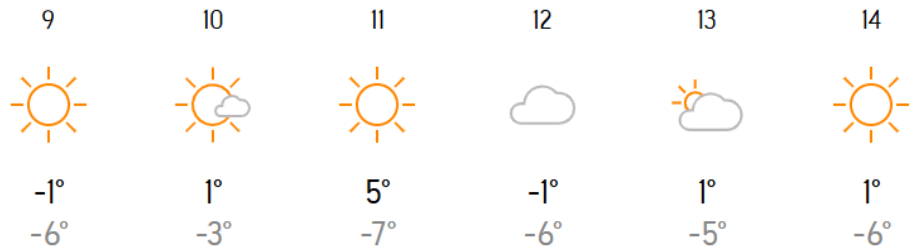

What to pack



- Thermal clothes (tops, leggings etc)
- Warm clothes! Jumpers, coats, hats, gloves etc
- COMFORTABLE waterproof shoes/boots
- Bag/backpack
- Sunglasses (it can get quite bright)
- Appropriate sleepwear for cold temperatures

- Passport
- Portable charger (keep in your hand luggage)
- Adaptor
- Water bottle
- Umbrella
- Cash/bank card/revolut (for snacks, lunches, drinks, metro etc). Recommend a minimum of £240
- Plastic/reusable bag for damp clothes
- Phone/camera

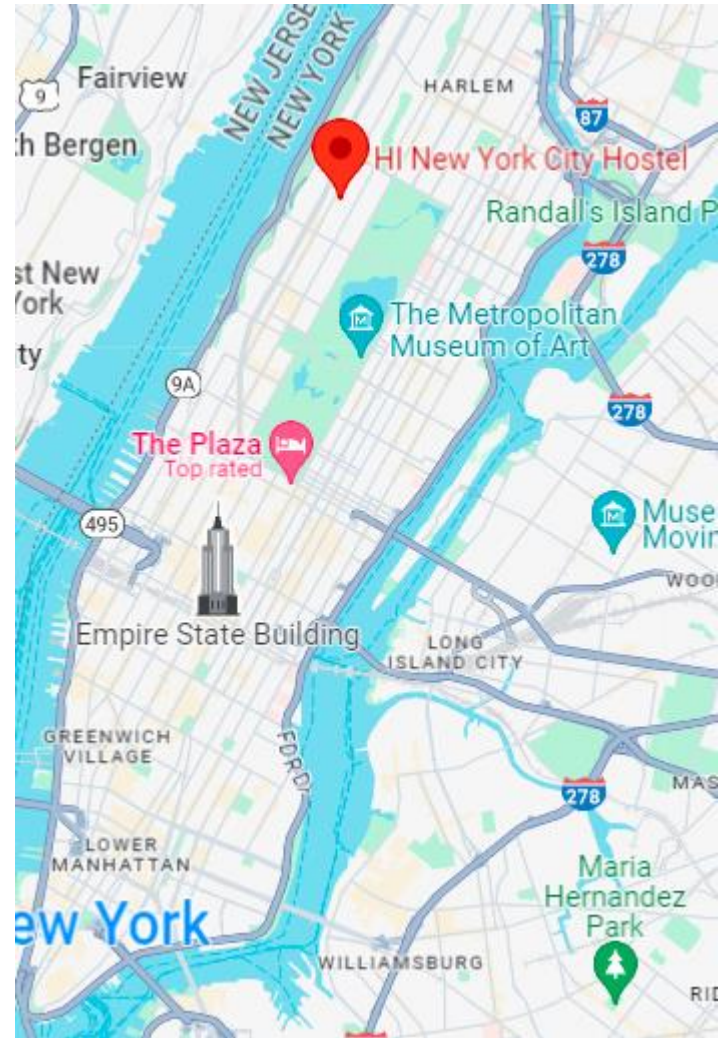
Logistics

- At the first hotel, staff will hold all passports at the hotels

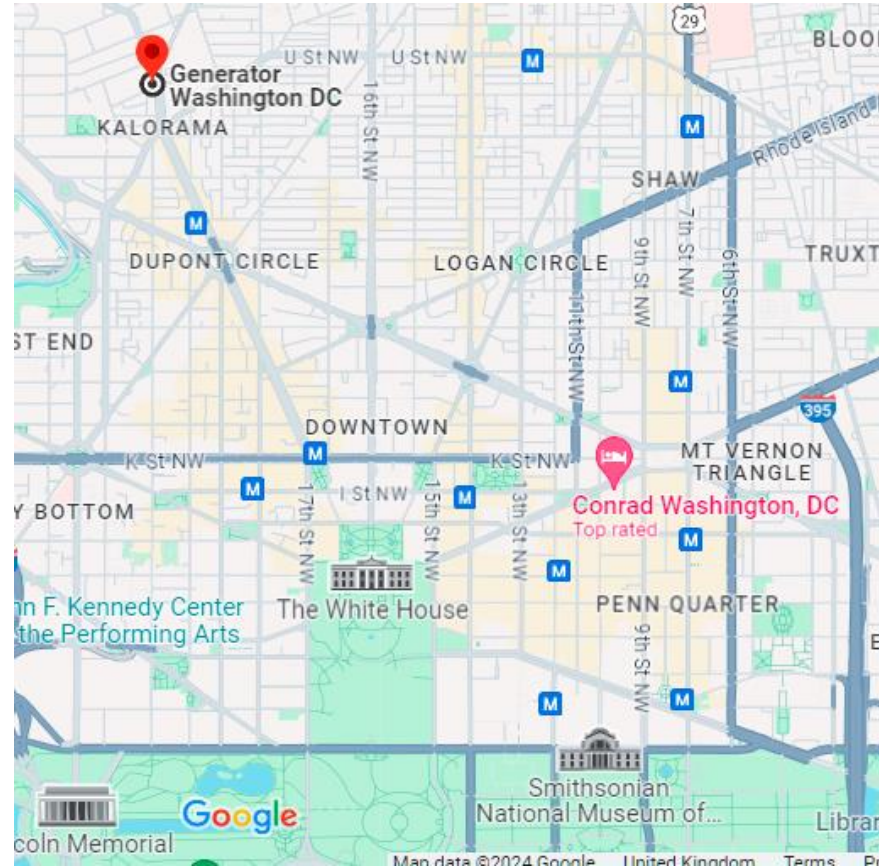
