### If you are not able to attend those dates......

These are the only dates that we are offering to attend with Ousedale school staff alongside BXM assessors. However, this does not mean that your Child will not be able to participate.

You have the following option:

You pay the DofE registration fee to the school and we will register your child and enrol them on the scheme. However,

you will need to make arrangements, independently, for

them to complete the expedition section of the award. This includes any training, the practice and the qualifying expedition.

BXM outdoors offers open expeditions, so we would recommend to book directly through BXM but this would be independent from the school.
