What is Labour Market Information (LMI)

Careers Labour Market Infromation (LMI) is at the heart of our careers programme, it describes a world in which young people are going to pursue their careers.

We use LMI every time we interact with someone regarding their future hopes and aspirations. Questions about course choices, employment, training, how much money could be earned in a particular job, where the local job vacancies can be found, what will the 'hot jobs' be when they leave education? None of these questions or issues could be addressed without LMI.

LMI can help to demystify the world of work and can help individuals achieve their career goals.

In summary, LMI provides knowledge and understanding of how the labour market functions and is crucial for making sense of changing economic circumstances. It can also help when thinking about what the future might hold, so can support our students with making decisions about a career field/pathway.
