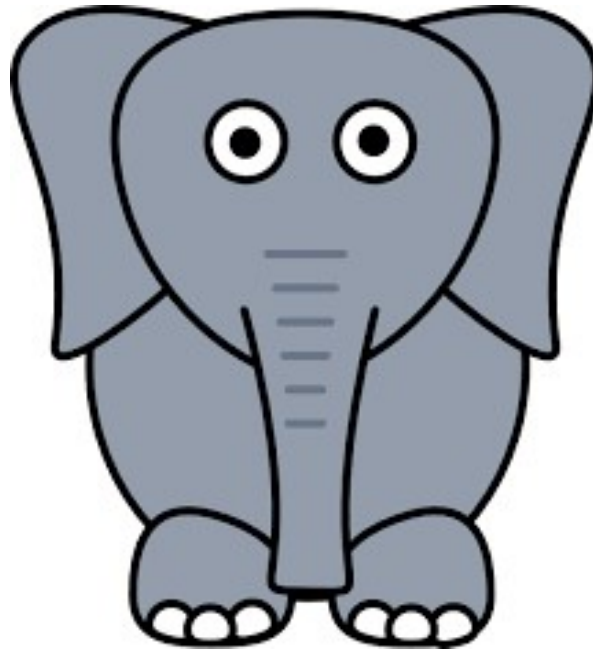

- ▶ You do not need to fill in every square!

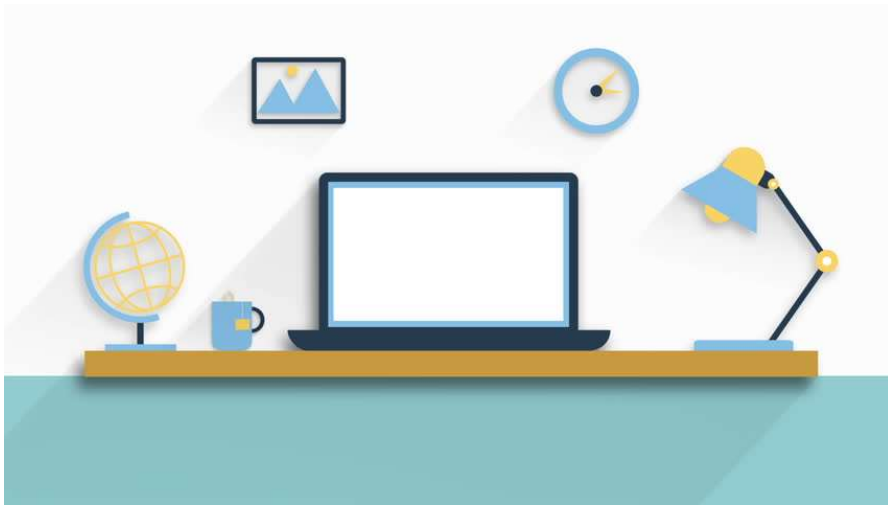









Passport to the Prom

- **Have a good behaviour record** in Year 11 from February half-term i.e. not excluded/suspended & positive Class Charts score (i.e. more positives than negatives from February)
- **Have a good attendance & punctuality record** i.e. in Year 11 from February half-term 93%+ with no more than 10 late marks to registration or lessons (known medical/SEND issues will be accounted for).
