Year 13 Celebration

Following my previous correspondence, we wish to say a fond farewell to our Year 13 students. Therefore, we have put on a morning of music, games and free food to allow for some heart-felt goodbyes between staff and students. As we are still operating a normal school day for our other Year groups, I ask that students arrive from 8:40am through the Drama Studios, where they will be directed to the main, upper field after an initial assembly. Students will hopefully join us, and will depart school from 11:10am onwards. Site must be clear of all Year 13 students by 11:30am. Note: Any student found to be consuming or carrying alcohol, will need to be collected by a parent/carer immediately from main reception.

Importantly, I would like to take this opportunity to thank the Student Leadership Team for their efforts in organising this event for their peers, who have been steadfast and efficient in booking all of these events, to ensure a celebration can be had.

Cashless Catering Accounts

Students leaving the school have the options of any remaining money in their cashless catering account being refunded to their parent(s), transferred to a younger brother's or sister's account or donated to charity. The Finance Office should be informed about which is preferred. Any money remaining in unused accounts after 30th September will be cleared and donated to the school's charities, Save The Children and Willen Hospice. After this date no refunds or transfers will be possible.

Results

Students will receive their exam results in School this year, or if preferred these can be attained by a peer or other family member if we have received consent from you, as Parent, to do so on your Son or Daughter's behalf. This should be sent to the exam officer's email by on Friday May 24th. Exam results are regarded as an individual's exclusive property and we regret that we cannot email them to parents. If students wish their results to be posted to them, they will need to provide a stamped addressed envelope to the Exams Office by Monday 17th June.

What further opportunities exist for Year 13?

If your Son/Daughter already has access arrangements for their exams, please note that these will already be taking place, well practise with subject Teachers in the final Progress Review most recently in Year 13.

Please remember that our careers Team remain on call to support your son/daughter at this transitional phase. Ms Moulds, myself and Mr Grant will also be able to support or offer further guidance and information should students require it, once they leave us on 10th May. There are also a range of summer schools, operating remotely and face to face now too, so please do not hesitate to contact us, should you wish to know more.
