



10 Golden Student Rules

REMEMBER THESE ARE DIFFICULT AND DIFFERENT TIMES IN SCHOOL BUT IF WE ALL FOLLOW THESE SIMPLE RULES WE WILL ALL STAY SAFE. THINK BEFORE YOU ACT!

Before you come to school each day ask yourself: Do you have?

Symptoms:

- A new continuous cough
- A loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell
- A temperature/ fever or you feel hot

If you do have the above symptoms you must not attend school and ask your parent/carer to contact your PAL immediately. **If you feel unwell** during the day please inform your teacher.

- 1. Always use** the correct gate and bike shed for your year group.
- 2. Always clean your hands** for 20 seconds and washing them as much as possible during the school day, especially after each break & in-between lessons if you can.
- 3. Always sanitise your hands** when entering and exiting a classroom (Sanitiser stations are in every classroom and around school).
- 4. Always enter and exit buildings** the right way and **always go up and down the right staircases** (All entrance, exits and staircases are clearly signposted)
- 5. Always walk** on the left in corridors and around school.
- 6. Always wear a mask** when approaching a teacher, in a corridor, toilet and moving from one lesson to another (your choice if you want to wear a mask in class).
- 7. Do not share equipment** and remember to wipe down, before and after use, any equipment you use, including tables and backs of chairs.
- 8. Classroom:**
 - You must stay behind your desk at all times;
 - Do not enter the area marked out for teachers;
 - Be punctual, fully equipped and wear your uniform correctly;
 - You must not disrupt the learning of others.
- 9. Behaviour:** Students **MUST** follow all school rules. **Any student who deliberately:**
 - coughs, sneezes or spits at or towards another student or member of staff;
 - refuses to wear a mask in corridors, toilets and between lessons;
 - chews gum;
 - vandalises toilet facilities, sanitiser stations etc;
 - puts any student or member of staff in danger due to their actions;

will face a fixed term or permanent exclusion from school.
- 10. Always** try your best in all lessons, ask for help and put safety first before doing anything.
