Dear parents and carers,

I hope you and your families are well.

Just a reminder that it is a staff training day on Thursday therefore, students are not required in school and hopefully, weather permitting, sports day for all year groups at both campuses on Friday. I know details have been sent out regarding this exciting day.

COVID Update

We have only had one positive case since the middle of last week and this did not result in any additional students having to self-isolate. However, could we all please ensure LFD tests are taken twice a week to help prevent the spread of infection and students having to self-isolate; please do not send in your sons/ daughters if they:

- Are not feeling well;
- Have any cold/flu-like symptoms;
- Headache/stomach ache;
- COVID-19 symptoms.

Or any member of the household has any of the above

And please follow the government guidelines to ensure everyone stays safe and healthy and can remain in school for the next couple of weeks.

Pupils must not come into the school if:

- *a member of their household (including someone in their support bubble or childcare bubble if they have one) has COVID-19 symptoms*
- *they are legally required to quarantine, having recently visited countries outside the Common Travel Area*
- *they have had a positive test*
- *have been in close contact with someone who tests positive for COVID-19*

They must immediately cease to attend and not attend for at least 10 days from the day after:

- *the start of their symptoms*
- *the test date if they did not have any symptoms but have had a positive LFD or PCR test (if an LFD test is taken first, and a PCR test is then taken within 2 days of the positive lateral flow test, and is negative, it overrides the LFD test and the pupil can return to school)*
